



## Home Learning Activities

### Rabbit Class 1.5.20



Hello Rabbits! I hope you are all feeling well and getting on ok at home. We are all missing you and looking forward to seeing you when schools are back to normal. I have made a list of activities for you to do with your grown ups at home, all about our new topic - **MINIBEASTS!**

I hope you enjoy doing them I look forward to seeing some photos of you completing your favourite activities.

Here are some activities for you to try this week:

1. Talk to your grown ups about what you know about **Minibeasts**. Where do you find them? What do they look like? You could draw pictures of your favourite minibeasts or write a list of all the minibeasts you can think of!
2. Go on a '**bug hunt**' around your house, garden or park. How many different minibeasts can you find? You could make a map of where you found them, or keep a tally of how many of each minibeast you found.
3. Listen to the story **The Hungry Caterpillar** (use Google to find a virtual version). Act out or retell the story with your grown ups. You could make all the different food from play doh or draw pictures of them to help.
4. Choose a few of your favourite minibeasts and **draw, colour** or **trace** them.
5. **Feelings** - Talk to your grownup about what makes you **excited** and how it makes you feel. Make a list of the most exciting things you can think of as a family!
6. **Maths** - Talk to your grown ups about **money** and what it is used for. Look at some coins (**1p, 2p, 5p +10p coins**) and see if you can remember what each one looks like (colour/size). Set up a 'play shop' using old boxes and make some price tags up to 10 or 20p.
7. **Phonics** - How many cvc words can you make using the following sounds?  
Words like - pin, hat, sat...

s a t p i n m d g o c k b r h u
