It's not uncommon to experience fatigue, sadness, difficulty concentrating, and a disruption in your sleep schedule during the winter season. With March around the corner we can hope for sunnier days. In the mean time here are some tips for beating those winter blues and to focus on the production of our 'Happy Hormones'.

Dopamine The rewarding chemical, to release this: Complete a task the best you can Do a mindful self-care activity Eating delicious food Celebrate an achievement Examples: help a friend, do something you really enjoy, listen to music, dance to a song.	Oxytocin The Cuddle Hormone decreases stress and anxiety through: Exercise Kind hands/Touch Music Examples: giving (and receiving) a smile, hugging your friends, cuddling, singing, holding hands with a friend.	
Endorphins They relieve pain and create a feeling of well-being through: Exercise Laughing Essential oils Meditation Examples are: mindful breathing, read a funny book, watch something that makes you laugh, exercise, stretching.	Serotonin The mood stabiliser and booster through: Exposure to the sun/light Being in nature Mindfulness Examples: have a snack, sit quietly and read a book or do some colouring, listen to a story, go for a walk outside, do some yoga or Tai Chi.

This term in Reception our topic is Shepton Mallet. We have been thinking about the places we know in Shepton Mallet and what our favourite place is. We have also started thinking about key landmarks in Shepton Mallet. We visited the viaduct and were amazed by how tall the arches are.


