If you are interested in becoming a Parent Governor but feel a little daunted by the responsibility you may be taking on, remember that full training will be available, and you will always act as part of a team. No particular experience or qualifications are required.

Reception's topic this term is dinosaurs and we have started looking at how the dinosaurs look the same and different, focusing in on their different features.

In Phonics we are recapping on previously learnt phonemes, working on our blending (reading) and segmenting (spelling) skills.

In Maths we have been using 5's frames to quickly work out how many more/less we need to add/take away to make numbers 0-5.



Year 1 have had a busy week continuing discovering facts about different dinosaurs, including sorting dinosaurs in science, writing captions to go with a picture of a dinosaur in English and investigating the properties of 3d and 2d shapes in maths.



Year 2 have had a brilliant week! In maths this week we have been thinking about the relationship between the 5 and 10 times table. In English, we have been writing about the life of Mary Anning. In history, we have been learning about Mary Anning and why she is so famous and in art we have been sketching some pictures of fossils.
